Children of John J. Durbin and Patience Logsdon

I. Rebecca, daughter of John J. Durbin and Patience Logsdon, was married to Jack Thomas, parentage unknown, in Hardin County, January 18, 1820.

We do not have much information on Jack and Rebecca Thomas; they apparently never moved to Edmonson County, but stayed in Hardin County. Jack seems to have died before the census of 1850. We are not positive the census records listed below are part of his family, but I believe it is.
